RULES FOR FORMATING SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES FOR PUBLICATION IN THE SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION JOURNAL “THE NEWSLETTER OF CAIMU”

An article in the journal can be submitted in one of three languages: Kyrgyz, Russian or English.

To ensure the high quality of the journal's materials, the editors ask authors to strictly follow the rules outlined below when submitting articles:

1. The total volume of the article, including literature, tables and figures, should not exceed 7-15 pages.

2. Articles must be written in a text editor MS Word 2003-2019 and edited strictly according to the following parameters:

- 2 cm margins around the perimeter of the page;

- Times New Roman font, font size for the entire article, except tables – 14 pt, font size for tables – 12 pt;

- line spacing – 1.5;

- alignment to page width;

- Page numbering, the use of page breaks in the text, the use of automatic page links, the use of automatic hyphens, and the use of sparse or condensed letter spacing are not allowed.

3. In the upper left corner is the UDC code.

4. The title of the article is in the center in capital, bold, 14 point, in three versions: in Russian, Kyrgyz and English.

5. In the upper right corner is the surname and initials of the author(s). Indicate places of work (you must provide the official FULL name of the institution without abbreviations). After the name of the institution, you must write the position held, the name of the city, and the country, separated by a comma. for students: course, full name of the educational program (specialty), full name of the department (faculty), full name of the educational institution, city;

for bachelors: course, full name of the direction/profile, full name of the faculty/institute, full name of the educational institution, city;

for master's students: course, full name of the direction, full name of the faculty/institute, full name of the educational institution, city;

for graduate students: full name of the department to which the graduate student is attached, full name of the faculty/institute, full name of the educational institution, city;

for teachers, teachers of additional education, workers in the field of culture and youth policy - academic degree, title, position, place of work - full name indicating all designations and identifiers.

6. Abstract in Russian, Kyrgyz, English. It is written in Times New Roman 12 font, 1 spaced, the word “Abstract” is in bold font, the annotation text is in non-bold font. The volume of abstract text for a Russian-language article should be 100-250 words. In other languages - according to the translation.

7. Key words in Russian, Kyrgyz, English. Must be presented in an amount of 7 to 10 words or phrases. The words “Keywords” are written in bold font, the keywords themselves are written in non-bold font. Placed immediately after the annotation text in the appropriate language.

8. Figures, graphs and tables should be located in the text after the reference to it.

9. Graphic material (photos, drawings, graphs, diagrams, including scanned ones) is presented in jpg format. The names and numbers of the graphic material must be indicated below the image.

10. Tables are typed in MS Word (font size 12). Tables must have numbers and titles, which must be indicated above the tables.

11. Abbreviations and symbols are allowed only for abbreviations of measures, physical, chemical and mathematical quantities, terms, etc. accepted in the international system of units.

12. All formulas must be typed in the formula editor.

13. The list of references is numbered in the order of references in the text. References are placed in square brackets, for example, [3], [5-7]. The bibliographic description of each source must comply with GOST.

14. Full name should be provided on a separate page. in full, academic degree, title, position, full postal address, telephone numbers, fax numbers, E-mail.
